Logic & Rhetoric Academic Agreement

Cornerstone Academy offers a unique opportunity in education by giving the parent the opportunity to share in a partnership with the classroom instructor. Scripture places the responsibility for training children on the father and mother. You, in turn, have delegated a portion of that responsibility to Cornerstone, a five-day school with a university model. Your student will spend three to four days at school and the remaining class days at home completing work that secondary instructors will assign. It is our goal as an administration to ensure your child's formal education is a success. This academic agreement identifies the responsibilities that you can expect your student's secondary instructors to fulfill. It also identifies the responsibilities that you, the homeschool parent, have agreed to fulfill by enrolling your student in this unique education.

You can expect your student's secondary instructors to:

- Instruct students on classroom days.
- Instruct you through in-service meetings on how to ensure productive homeschool days.
- Maintain an online assignment sheet, including due dates, which may also be sent home with students (weekly to quarterly).
- Provide all curricula needed some of which may also be posted on an instructor's website.
- Maintain grades in Gradelink on a weekly basis.
- Contact you if your student's quarterly average drops below 75%.

I, the homeschool parent, agree to:

- Provide my student with supervision, structure and access to a distraction-free environment on homeschool days.
- Plan alternative time to accommodate students involved in extra-curricular activities
- Attend in-service meetings when provided.
- Review and follow the assignment sheet.
- Review homeschool assignments for neatness and completion.
- Encourage my student to submit work on the next school day unless an alternative due date is given by the instructor, emphasizing that late work is not accepted.
- Review Gradelink on a weekly basis and set it to send an email alert when my student earns a grade that is lower than acceptable or receives an incomplete.
- Provide my student's instructors with two weeks advance notice for absences due to circumstances not related to illness or emergency.
- Teach or provide a tutor to teach concepts to my student that have been missed due to absences (planned or unplanned) from in-school days.
- Ensure all work missed during absences is completed and submitted by the due date provided by my student's instructors.
- Ensure all textbooks/materials are returned in usable condition or will reimburse Cornerstone for any assessed damages.
