All fees are non-refundable. Due to the fact that the school contracts with our teachers and staff to pay them a set amount for the year regardless of any reduction in student population, and in consideration of the per student costs we incur in materials and overhead for the year, we cannot refund any application, intent to attend, or tuition fees.

Multiple Student Discount

Cornerstone Academy provides a tuition discount to families with more than one child simultaneously attending full-time in grades Pre-K through 12. The discount is 5% for the second student, 10% for the third student, and 15% for the fourth student. Students receiving financial assistance from McKay or Step Up for Students are not eligible for a multi-student discount.

Tuition Payment Options

Statement of Faith

6. We believe that faith without works is dead.
7. We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit, by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a godly life.
8. We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; they that are saved to the resurrection of life and they that are lost to the resurrection of damnation.
9. We believe in the spiritual unity of all believers in our Lord Jesus Christ.
